Sub:- Issue regarding omission of অনুমতি দং (Permissive Possession) in the matter of
Sanat Chatterjee.

Ref Memo – 3185/LR/MISC(JOYPUR)/26, Dated. 27.07.2026 of your Office.

Apropos the subject and reference above, he is requested to reconsider the matter related to
omission of অনুমতি দং (Permissive Possession) on the following points:

1. The earlier order of the DLR&S & Joint LRC, WB clearly indicates that the "Permissive
Possession" remark can be removed on the basis of field enquiry and other documents/
evidence if that person is not found in possession.

2. Permissive Possession remark does not denote any legal right and is merely indicative in
nature about the factum of possession. Therefore, asking for death certificates or legal heirs
NOCs does not seem to be necessary as it is not a heritable right.

On the contrary, if the Permissive Possessor is not present in the field and RI report confirms
the same, that should be enough to draw up a proceeding to remove the remarks.

3. Yet to be safe and ensure that a chance of being heard is given, a general notice may be given
through newspaper/ notice board to invite objections from the Permissive Possessor.
