Whereas it appears that the 69 (sixty-nine) Forest Villages converted into Revenue Villages in the district of Alipurduar vide Notification No. 2802-LP dated 17.10.2014 as to provide forest rights to forest dwelling Schedule Tribes and other traditional forest dwellers on all forest lands under Section 3(1)(h) of the Schedule Tribes and Other Traditional Forest Dwellers (Recognition of Forest Right) Act, 2006,

And whereas the District Land & Land Reforms Officer, Alipurduar has after field survey duly submitted to the D.L.R. & S. and Joint L.R.C., W.B. a proposal that, the 6 (six) Mouzas have more than one sheet per Mouza having no common boundary with the sheets of the same Mouza and therefore require redetermination of area of the existing 6 (six) Revenue Villages by splitting and amalgamation specified in the schedule by creation of 8 (eight) separate new Revenue Villages and making a total number of 14 (fourteen) Revenue Villages as reconstituted unit of Survey & Record,

And whereas the D.L.R. & S. and Joint L.R.C, W.B. after due examination of the proposal has recommended the proposal of adopting 6 (six) Mouzas i.e Revenue Villages and creation of 8 (eight) new Mouzas i.e. Revenue Villages as new unit of Survey & Records as shown in the Schedule,

Now, therefore, in exercise of the power conferred by sub-para (2) of para 3 of Schedule A to W.B.L.R.Rules, 1965 and in exercise of the power conferred by Clause (7) of Section 3 of Land Registration Act, 1876 (Bengal Act VII of 1876), the Governor is pleased to sanction to re-determine 6 (six) existing Mouzas and create 8 (eight) new Mouzas making a total number of 14 (fourteen) Mouzas i.e. Revenue Villages as reconstituted unit of Survey and Settlement Operation as specified in the Schedule below, when the notification adopting them as such, is issued in official gazette.
