
Sub: Collection of Land Revenue and reporting there upon

From the revenue receipt report under major head 0029 as generated from IFMS, it is observed that there is a sharp fall of land revenue in the tune of Rs. 33.44 cr. in 2018-19 compare to 2017-18. Though some exemptions of tax have been made in some cases in recent past, still there is scope for enhancement of land revenue. The matter was discussed in the State Level Conference of District Land & Land Reforms Officers held on 17.6.19 & 18.6.19. It was decided that more thrust should be given for collection of land revenue on non-agricultural land.


It is also observed that revenue collection reports are prepared on the basis of some specific detailed head of accounts. But after analysing IFMS, it is observed that we have as many as 51 (fifty one) detailed head of accounts for collection of land revenue and other government dues relating to L&LR RR&R establishment. The detail head wise revenue collection report for the year 2018-19 is enclosed with.

Apropos, you are requested to generate non-agricultural land revenue dues list from e-bhuchitra and give emphasis for collection of those revenue as per prevailing rules.

You are also requested to explore possibility of increasing revenue collection on all heads and send revenue & other government dues collection report on all 51 detailed head of accounts to the Director of Land Records and Surveys as per prevailing system.
